In September of 2022, Hurricane Ian made landfall in Florida and was the most destructive hurricane to strike the state since 1935, leaving many displaced and unable to live in their homes. Join us for a week-long mission trip providing restoration to some of the most devastated communities. No previous experiences needed, just a servant's heart.

TRANSPORTATION (AIR AND GROUND):

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Classrooms have been converted into sleeping rooms for host teams. Portable twin beds with mattresses and a pillow are provided. A portable shower building is provided a few steps away from the sleeping quarters. Traditional church restrooms are across the hall from the sleeping quarters. Trip participants are responsible for their bedding/towels.

MEALS:

Most meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) will be prepared and served in the church kitchen. We will pack a sack lunch to be eaten at the work site. One evening meal is provided by the host church.

TRIP STRUCTURE:

Each day will follow a similar structure. With the exception of Wednesday, we will be on the work site from 9 am to 3 pm, each full day of our trip. At the conclusion of our work day, we will return to our host church for free time, structured activities, dinner, and evening devotions. Wednesday will be a recreational day with a visit to the beach and dinner at a local restaurant.

WORK SITE:

We will be working on home restoration. Within two weeks of our trip, we should know the exact location of the home(s) that we will be working on. The type of work may include: mucking/gutting a house, installing drywall/insulation, clearing debris and tree stumps from yards, removing and installing new flooring, roof work, etc. A job coordinator will be at each job site for the entire time our group is at a site. No previous experience is needed. The job coordinator will give instructions and lessons on-site. Due to the large size of our group, we may be split in half and work concurrently at two different work sites. They usually have 6-7 workers at one time per site. All building supplies and materials will be provided. Restrooms are provided at each work site. We will have lunch on the work site (sack lunch). Work teams need to provide work gloves, goggles, and N95 masks.
